

# Transition to In-Person Learning

The transition from Distance Learning to In-Person Learning may involve a Hybrid phase.



TRANSITIONAL HYBRID MODEL

Assigned cohorts will attend in-person on specific days, limiting the number of students on campus at any given time.



#### COVID-19 Compliance Team

A COVID-19 Compliance Team has been formed which is responsible for establishing & enforcing all COVID-19 safety protocols



#### Symptom Screening

Students and staff must complete daily symptom screenings & temperature checks before entering campus.



#### Social Distancing

Social distancing will be practiced and large gatherings avoided while on campus.



#### **Employee Training**

All employees participated in Safety Training to ensure that best safety practices were understood and followed.



#### Frequent Cleaning

Surfaces and facilities in the school will be cleaned and disinfected frequently.



#### Face Masks

Face coverings are required in settings where social distancing cannot be maintained.

#### **Tiered Supports**

A multi-tiered system of supports will be used to provide students with targeted aid depending on their level of need.

#### **Staff Mental Health**

Staff wellness webinars on a variety of topics designed to address trauma and other impacts of COVID-19 will be available to staff.



#### SUPPORT FOR UNDUPLICATED STUDENTS



**Foster Youth & Homeless Students** receive regular check-ins to ensure that basic needs (food, housing, transportation, emotional wellbeing) are being met.



**English Learners** receive targeted small group ELD designated instruction for 30 minutes during the day.



**Special Education Students** who require instruction beyond an online platform receive materials & support that target each of their individual learning needs.
